Is the driveway done? I believe you said if we bought the house you would do all the raking *and* the shoveling.

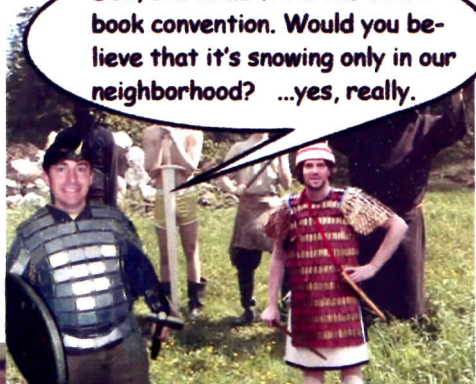




On a cold morning in January, Debbie quickly learned about the harsh realities of home ownership. While later that day...
