In March, the couple's dryer broke down.



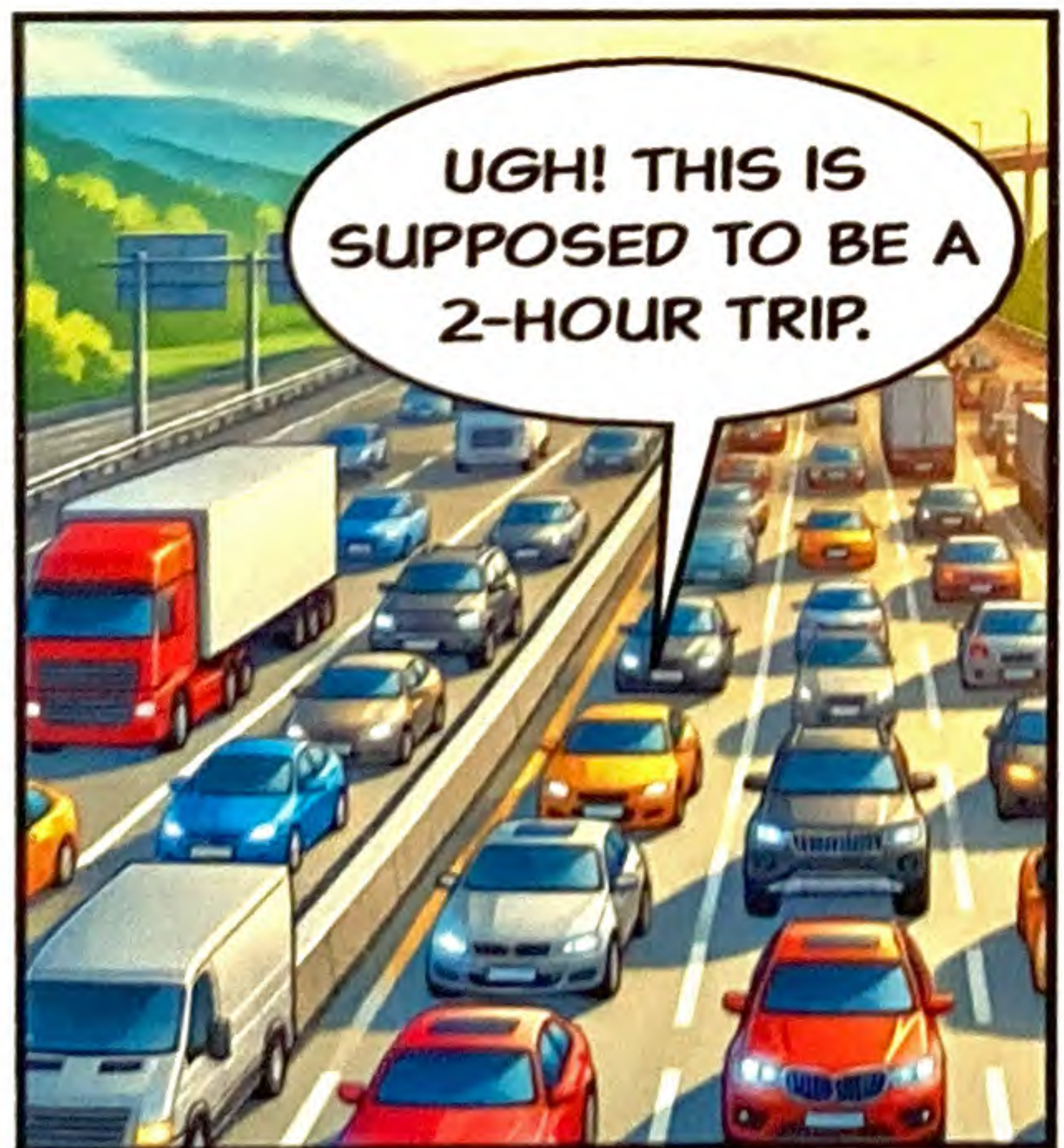
In April, Mark's knee began to mysteriously swell up.

In July, the couple spent 4 hours of quality time together heading to the family reunion.



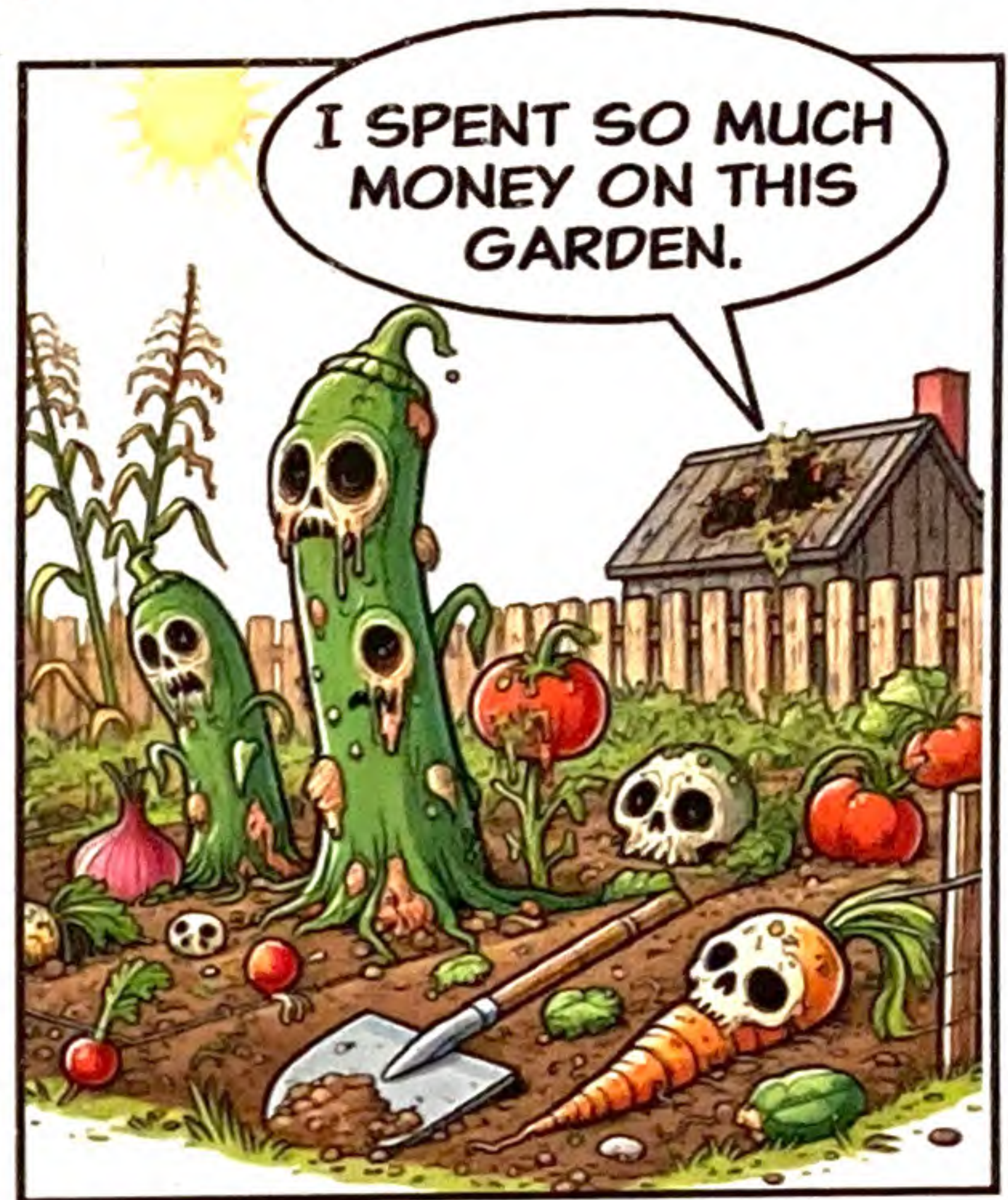
In July, a tree fell grazing the house. In August, a second tree toppled puncturing the roof.



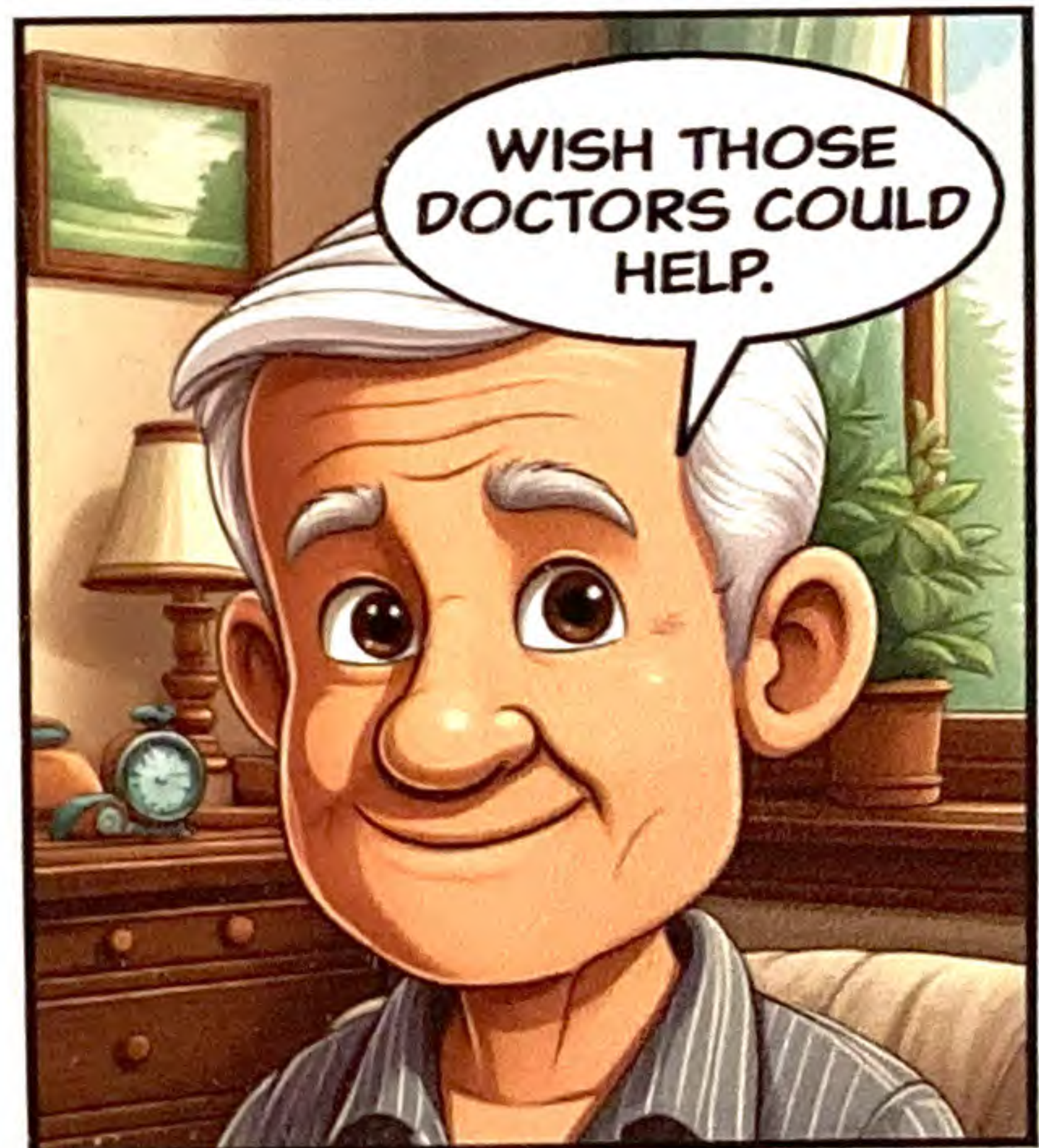
In October, they decided the trees closest to the house must come down.
